HRHCare MOBILE HEALTH

Thanks to funds raised at our Honoring the Hands Benefit in Riverhead this past July, we purchased a second mobile health center to serve patients on Long Island. Visiting farms, vineyards, community agencies, and churches across Suffolk County, this health center on wheels will bring care directly to people who often go without it, due to lack of transportation, limited funds, or the inability to leave work without jeopardizing their livelihood.

Our first mobile health center van, sponsored by ArchCare, has served over 1,000 patients in six counties across the Hudson Valley over the past year.

HRHCare currently has 10 patient shuttles that transport patients to and from their health center appointments across our network. A new 15-passenger patient shuttle will hit the roads of Rockland County in early 2018.

HRHCare hosted several events across our network for National Health Center Week – a time designated each year by the National Association of Community Health Centers to celebrate the vital role that health centers play in our communities. This year’s National Health Center Week theme was “Celebrating America’s Health Centers: The Key to Healthier Communities.”

To kick off the week, Congressman Peter King and Assemblywoman Kimberly Jean-Pierre joined HRHCare executives and Community Health Care Association of New York State CEO, Rose Duhan, for a tour of HRHCare Amityville, the Maxine S. Postal Health Center. Then the official HRHCare “National Health Center Week Van” hit the road, crisscrossing our 10-county service area for staff appreciation and outreach events. Special open houses were held at HRHCare health centers in Poughkeepsie, Goshen, and Southampton for patients, community partners, and elected officials. The visit of the *All of Us* Research Program mobile unit (see p. 9) to the Peekskill Health Center was also a key feature of National Health Center Week.
