

Achievements

- Our 340b program provide patients with critical medications at low-to-no cost, including HIV medications and Suboxone
- In-house pharmacy
- One of six HIV Undetectables Programs in NYC with 200 patients enrolled, all of whom have achieved over 90% viral load suppression rate
- Successful Transitional Care Program, funded by the Robin Hood Program, provides community-based engagement for high-risk patients with HIV, diabetes, or hypertension
- Expanded Adult Day Health Care program
- Successful TransHealth advocacy and support program offers education and pre/postoperative support for transgender individuals
