Achievements

- Successful community outreach events, including LGBTQ youth focused programs
- Our 340b program provide patients with critical medications at low-to-no cost, including HIV medications and Suboxone
- Expanded the Article 31 program to link children, adolescents, and families with behavioral health services
- Implemented Project SUCCEED, with the NYC Department of Health Viral Hepatitis Division to identify HIV/HCV positive patients and link them with care resulting in 68% of patients with hep C having an undetectable viral load
- Received the only SAMHSA Patient Navigation grant in New York State to connect young MSM and transgender women to medical and supportive social services
- Successful opioid replacement therapy program for opioid use disorder
- Successful TransHealth advocacy and support program offers education and pre/post-operative support for transgender individuals
